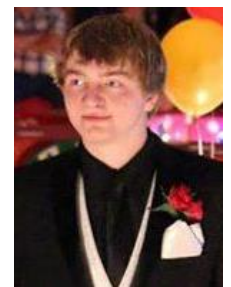

**Gabe & Melissa Roetman**, who were married April 25 at Christ Lutheran Church.

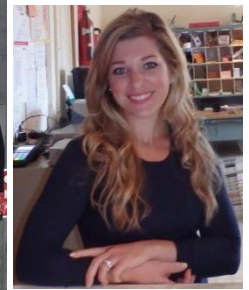
**Carly Olson**, who was missed by town citizens while she was out taking tests to continue working at the Brunsville Post Office. She passed, of course, & the town welcomes her back.

## Recipe of the Month: Really real strawberry cupcakes

Makes 20 standard cupcakes. Prep: 30 min.; cook time: 17 min.; ready in 47 min.

1 1/4 oz. freeze-dried strawberries

3/4 cup cake flour

1/4 tsp. baking soda

1/2 cup unsalted butter, room temperature

3 eggs, room temperature

2/3 cup whole milk, room temperature

3/4 cup all-purpose flour

1 1/2 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. salt

1 1/3 cups white sugar

1 tsp. vanilla extract

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Line muffin tins with 20 cupcake liners (for mini cupcakes, line 72 mini muffin tins).
2. Grind strawberries into a fine powder using a coffee grinder or food processor. Whisk strawberry powder, all-purpose flour, cake flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt together in a bowl.
3. Beat butter and sugar in a bowl with an electric mixer until light and fluffy. Mixture should be noticeably lighter in color. Add room-temperature eggs one at a time, allowing each egg to blend into butter mixture before adding the next. Beat in vanilla extract.
4. Stir flour mixture, alternately with the milk, into butter mixture until just incorporated. Fill lined tins with cupcake batter.
5. Bake in preheated oven until cupcakes spring back when gently touched with a fingertip or a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 16-18 min. for regular cupcakes, 8 to 10 min. for mini cupcakes.
